Summer 2012 CSA Agreement Mountain Meadows Farm

CSA is a commitment for the entire growing season.

Our responsibilities are as follows:

- 1) For the Fruit CSA you will receive 2-3 kinds of freshly picked fruit for most of the season. For the first and last weeks of the season, you may receive 1-2 kinds of fruit depending on the maturity dates that are weather dependent and vary slightly from year to year. Your share will meet or exceed the market value of \$15 each week.
- 2) For the Vegetable CSA you will receive a half bushel box full of seasonal vegetables. This should feed a family of 4, or 2 people who cook often. Your share will include 7-10 different vegetable items per week, with variety being the key.

Your responsibilities are as follows:

- 1) Pay for your share before the season begins.
- 2) You must pick up at the same time and place each week. If you plan to be out of town, please make prior arrangements for someone to pick up your box for you or as a gift to enjoy for themselves. Our planting, harvesting, and delivery schedules are based on you picking up your box at the regularly scheduled day and time.
- 3) Please return your box & containers each week so that we may reuse them.
- 4) Unfortunately we cannot take special requests or change items within a box. We will offer recipes on our website throughout the season to help with cooking vegetables that may be unfamiliar to you if any.
